Quick Start Guide



The Kajeet SmartSpot® is a portable Wi-Fi hotspot that extends the school day by providing fast, filtered broadband access anywhere.





POWER BUTTON: Powers the Kajeet SmartSpot on and off and wakes the screen from sleep mode.

STATUS DISPLAY: Provides connection and battery status, network signal strength, and the number of connected users.

SELECT BUTTON: Used to select menu options.

NAVIGATION BUTTONS: Scroll left or right through the available menu options.

SMARTSPOT CHARGING PORT: The AC charger supplied with your SmartSpot connects here.

ACCESSORY CHARGING PORT: This port can be used to charge other devices via USB.

Accessing

Your Kajeet SmartSpot Wi-Fi Name and Password

To access your Wi-Fi name and password follow the steps below.

- Make sure the Kajeet SmartSpot device is powered on and is on the home screen (if the screen is off, press the power button to exit sleep mode).
- Use the left and right arrows to navigate through the menu options until you see 'Wi-Fi Name/Password'.
- Press the select button to display the Wi-Fi name and password.
- 4. When done, press the select button two more times to return to the home screen.

Connecting

To Your Kajeet SmartSpot

Once you have located the Kajeet SmartSpot Wi-Fi name and password, you can now connect to the Internet with these simple instructions.

- 1. Make sure the Kajeet SmartSpot device is powered on.
- On your computer, tablet, mobile phone, or other Wi-Fi enabled device, select the Kajeet SmartSpot Wi-Fi network name (ex. Verizon-MiFi6620L-####) from the list of available wireless networks.
- 3. When prompted, type your Wi-Fi password and click OK.
- Your device is now connected to the Internet. You will
 receive a verification message on the Kajeet SmartSpot
 that a device has connected.
